

Certified Professional In Learning and Performance (CPLP) Program Statistics
As of December 28, 2008

Purpose

Certification program accreditation guidelines ¹ stipulate that a summary of certification activities must be published. These activities include the number of candidates examined, pass and fail statistics, and the number of individuals currently certified.

History

The CPLP program pilot administration took place in June 2005 and September 2005. The program launched operationally in July 2006. The first CPLP credentials were awarded on April 1, 2006.

CPLP Knowledge Exam²

From June 2005 – December 2008, there have been 13 knowledge exam administrations. A total of 1,466 exams have been administered.

Candidates must answer approximately 76% of the non-experimental items correctly to pass the knowledge exam. Of the 150 items, there are approximately 30 experimental items per test. The number of experimental items on the exam can vary slightly per testing window.

CPLP Work Product Exam³

From June 2005 – December 2008, there have been six work product submission windows. A total of

Candidates were required to score 12 points or greater out of a total of 18 points on the work product assessment to pass.
